Floorplan

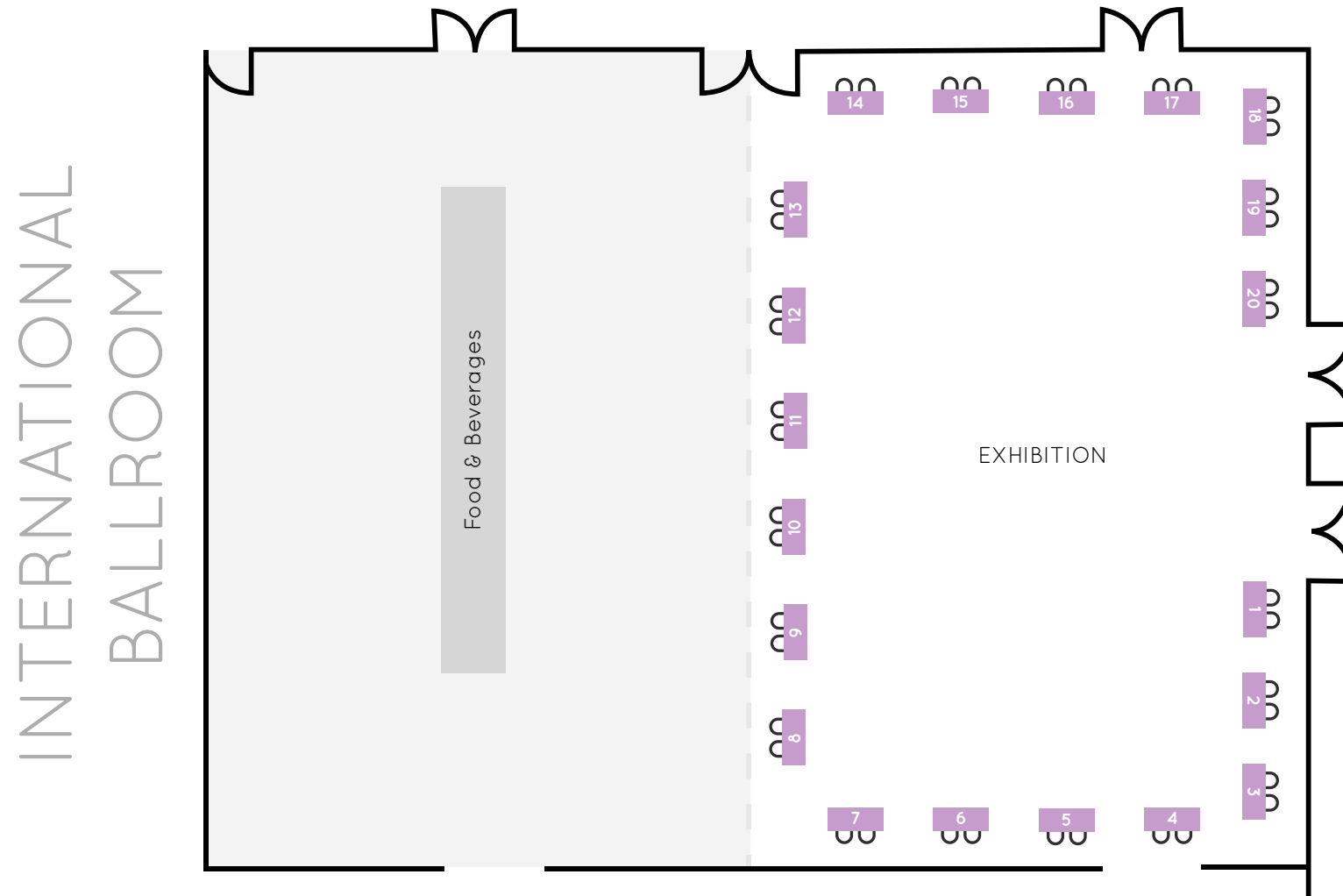
