Dr. Goldberg earned his medical degree from Yale University School of Medicine. He completed his dermatology residency and dermatologic surgical fellowship at New York University Medical Center. Dr. Goldberg was the first ever recipient of the ASLMS Leon Goldman award named after the founder of laser medicine.
